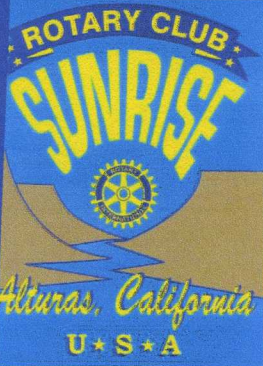

Joe Catania brought in City of Alturas Officials Joe Picotte and Chester Robertson to talk about our Airport. Below are Federal Guidelines for rural airports.

Department of Transportation (DOT's) Operating Administrations distribute substantial funds each year to finance construction projects initiated by state and local governments, and public transit and airport agencies. The Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21), enacted June 9, 1998, authorized the Federal surface transportation programs for highways, highway safety, and transit for the 6-year period 1998-2003. Section 1101(b) of the act (Disadvantaged Business Enterprises) states except to the extent that the Secretary determines otherwise, not less than 10% of the amounts made available for any program under Titles I, III, and V of this act shall be expended with small business concerns owned and controlled by socially and economically individuals.

The Department's most recent surface program reauthorization "the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU), enacted in 2005, extended the DBE program to the Department's highway and safety research program. Recipients of DOT funds must develop and implement a DBE program that conforms to DOT standards set forth in [49 CFR Part 23](#) (for airport concessionaires) and [49 CFR Part 26](#).
