

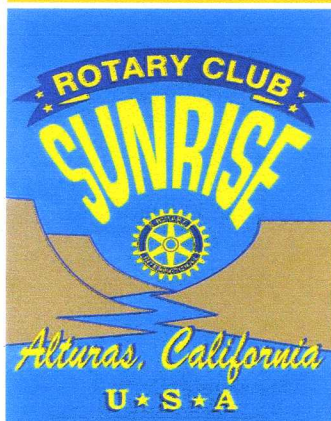

Sheriff Mike Poindexter stopped by to give us "The State of Modoc" address on Law Enforcement.

Speaker was Mike Poindexter regarding progress made since he took office and dispatch update. Improved budget, p&p, morale. Had to make some tough decisions based on what is right, not based on politics, organizational changes, training (guns and first aid), risk factors are down. 1 shift is covered during the day, volunteers are great help. Everyone is watching and pulling together. Dispatch still underfunded. Six departments still have not contributed and have notice until the 19th. Service is still effective, Mike responds to calls. He works average of 12 hr days 6 days per week. there have been more serious crimes this last year. Still looking for grants. AB109 is coming.

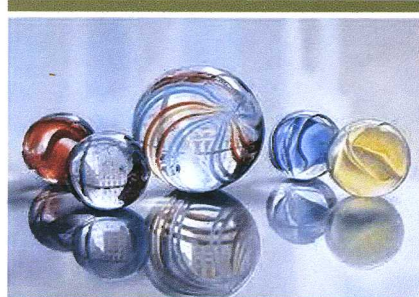
AB109 is not to be confused with AB109 of 2000 which is the "Kin Care" law. AB 109 changes the law to realign certain responsibilities for lower level offenders, adult

parolees and juvenile offenders from state to local jurisdictions. AB 109 will give local law enforcement the right and the ability to manage offenders in smarter and cost-effective ways.

Under AB 109:

- No inmates currently in state prison will be released early.
- All felons sent to state prison will continue to serve their entire sentence.
- All felons who are convicted of a serious or violent offense—including sex offenders and child molesters—will go to state prison.
- Felons who are not eligible for state prison can serve their sentence at the local level. Governor Jerry Brown also recently signed AB 111 today, which gives counties additional flexibility to access funding to increase local jail capacity for the purpose of implementing AB 109.
