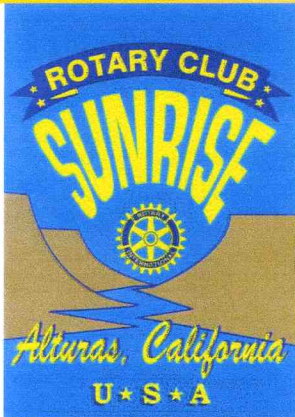

People brand animals that are valuable to them so it makes good sense to brand personal belongings that are also valuable. For horseman there is always risk that their high quality tack and equipment could be lost or stolen. Using miniature branding irons to permanently mark one's personal belongings will lessen the risk of theft. In the event that a branded piece of equipment is lost, chances are much more likely that it will be returned to the owner as it can now be easily identified. Brand-

ing your personal belongings with miniature brands is not only practical, it's also fun! In fact, many crafty people choose to incorporate branded items into their western home decor. It can be much more fun and cost effective to personalize your home decor items by branding them as opposed to buying items already featuring miscellaneous brands. 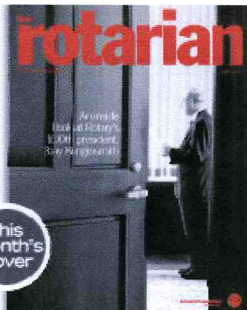
