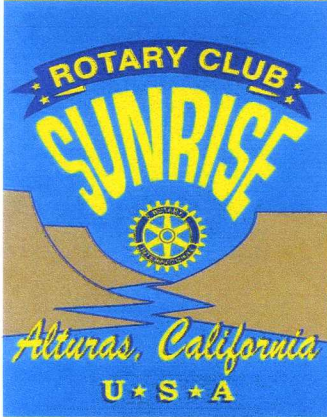

Monica has asked for members to think about being President for 2012-5013.

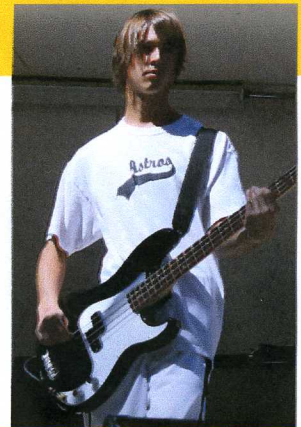
